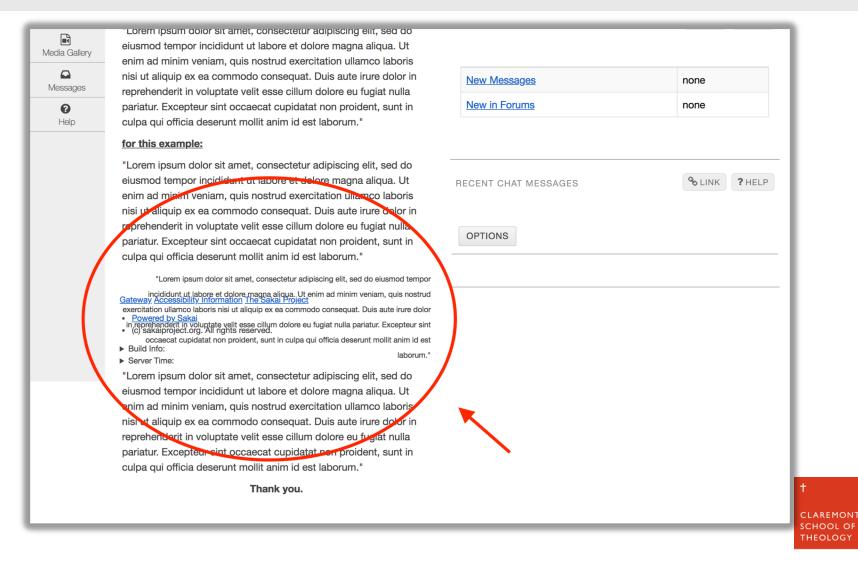

Getting Rid of Overlap on Your Course Site's Overview/Home Page

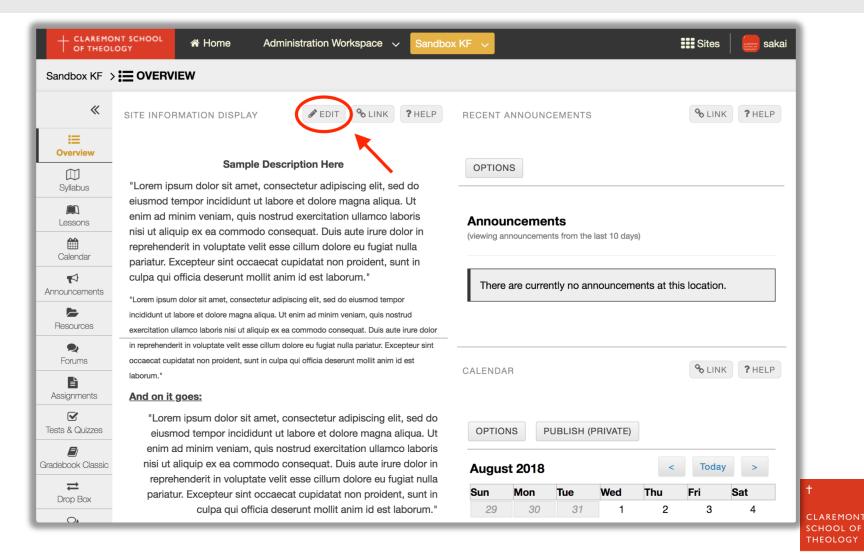

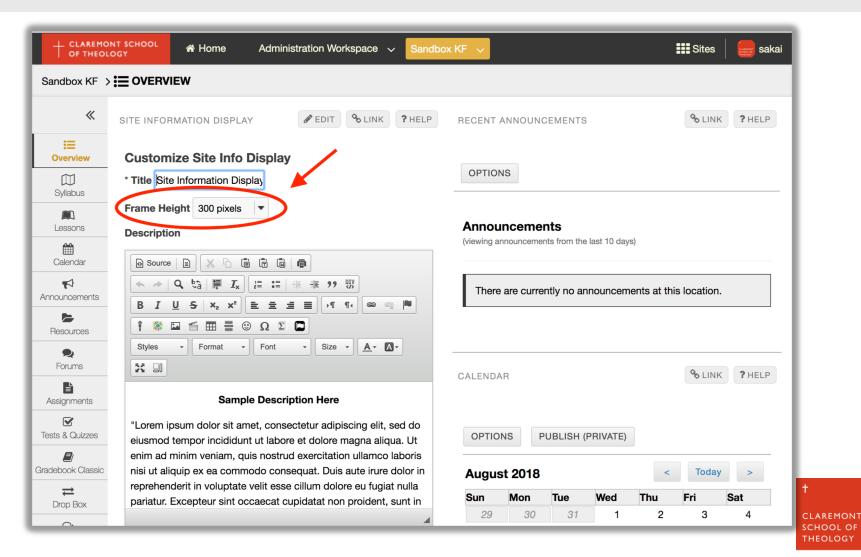
I. If your Site Information Display box on the Overview page is suffering from "overlap" with the links at the bottom of the page, don't worry! There's a simple fix.




2. Scroll back to the top of the Overview page, then click the "Edit" button at the top of the Site Information Display box.



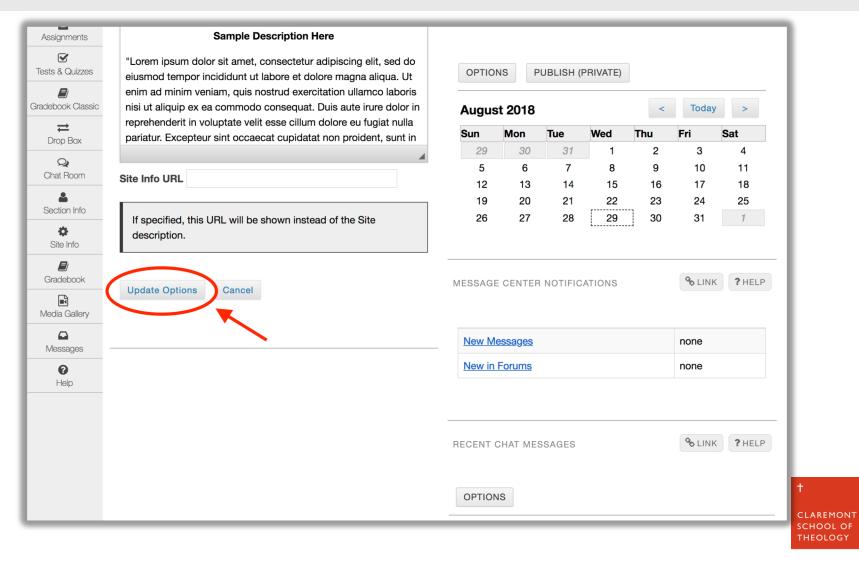
3. The "Frame Height" option will be just above the text box. You can click on the "Frame Height" dropdown box to pixel height options.



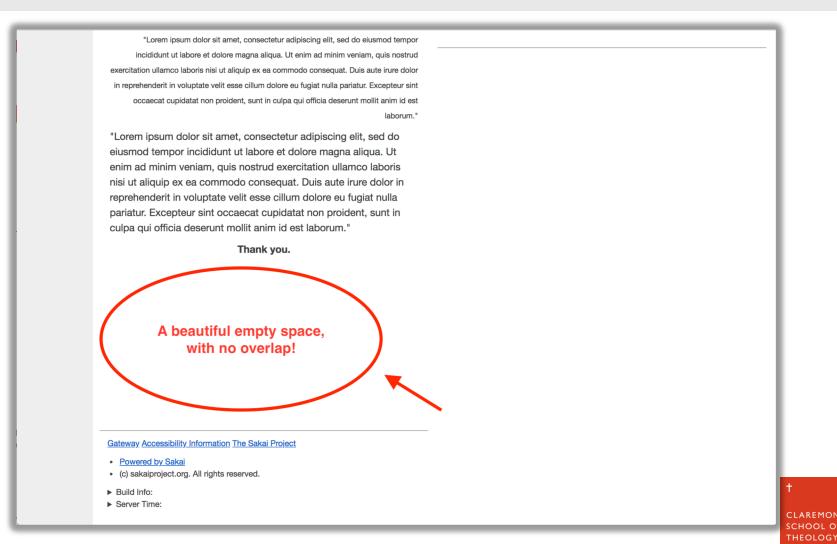
4. You can now choose the pixel height needed for the frame of your Site Information Display.



5. Click the "Update Options" button at the bottom of the page to save your changes. This will take you back to the Overview page.



6. Now scroll to the bottom of your Overview page to check. If there is still "overlap", click "Edit" again and choose a larger frame option.
